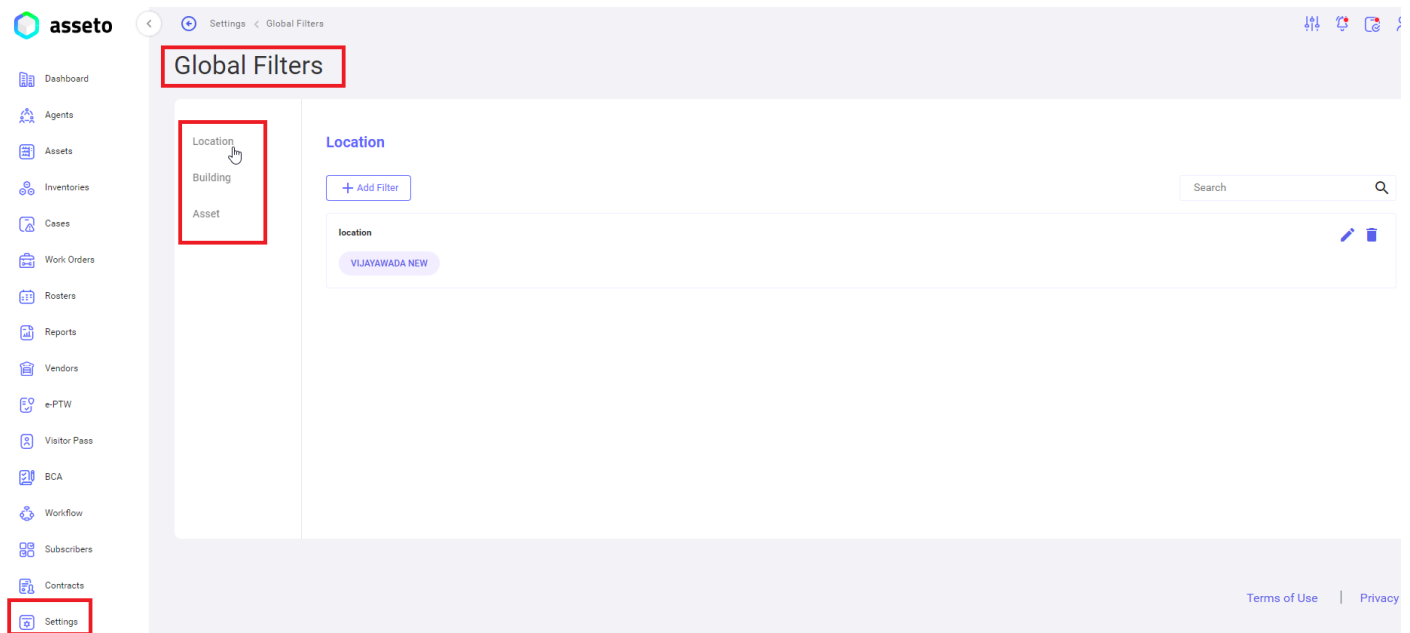


3. Global Filters

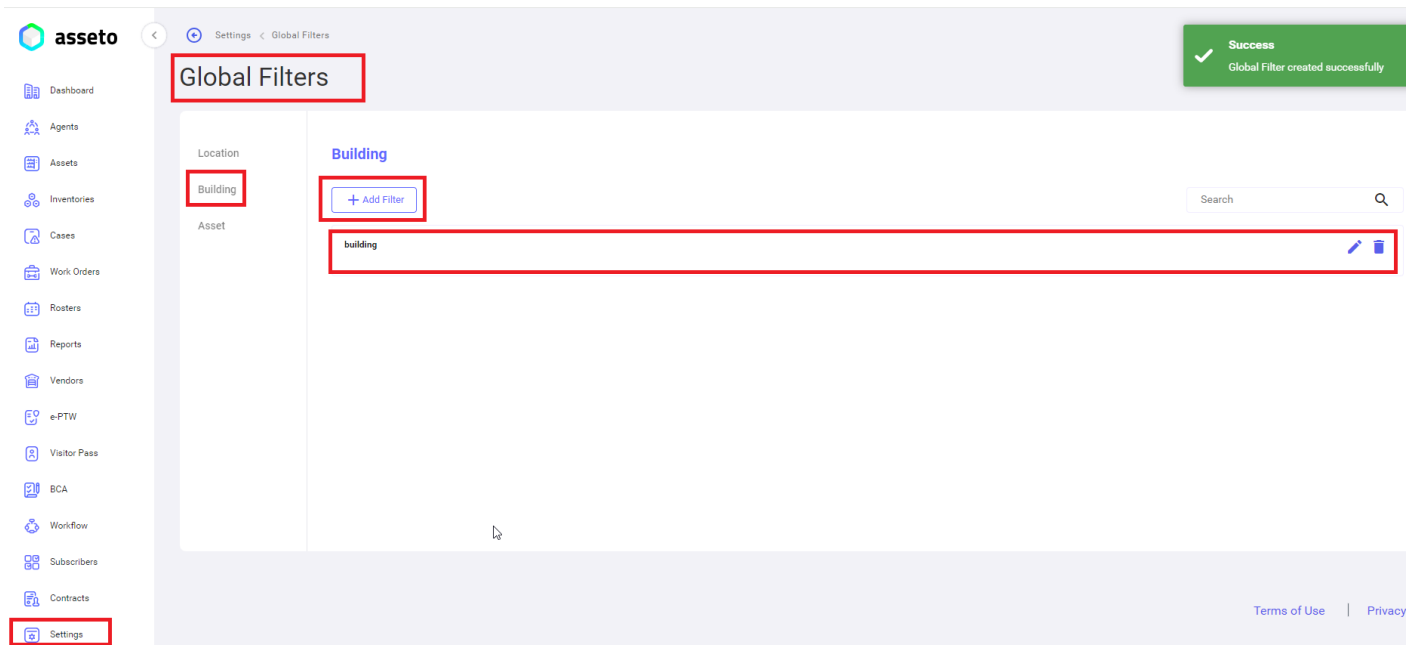
